BP 2715 Code of Ethics

The Board of Education may by action establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board of Education in its responsibilities.

Board of Education committees that are only advisory have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board of Education. Findings or recommendations shall be reported to the Board of Education for consideration.

An individual Board Member has the authority to represent the Board when authorized by a specific Board motion and/or when requested by the Board chair or designee.

The Board of Education has established a Budget Committee as required by law and will form other committees as needed to address the needs of the Board.

Committees of the Board of Education are governing bodies subject to Oregon Public Meeting Law.
