The Board of Education is the ultimate decision-maker in those areas assigned to it by state and federal laws and regulations. In executing that responsibility, the Board of Education is committed to its obligation to ensure that appropriate members of the College participate in developing recommended policies for Board of Education action and administrative procedures for Presidential action under which the Clatsop Community College is governed and administered.

The Joint Policies and Procedures Committee, representing college employees, Associated Student Government (ASG), President's Cabinet, College Council, and the DEI Council, shall participate in the decision-making processes of the College.

Chapter 2 policies and procedures do not have to go through the shared governance process because Chapter 2 policies and procedures related to the Board of Education itself. This does not preclude the Board from asking others to review.

Any duty imposed upon the Board of Education as a body shall be performed at a regular or special meeting and shall be made a matter of record. The consent to any particular measure obtained from individual Board of Education members when the Board of Education is not in session shall not be an act of the Board of Education and shall not be binding upon the district.
